Background

Job Purpose

To support the Head Coach of the team you are appointed to at the 2019 Softball Australia International Friendship Series.

Job Responsibilities

Support the Head Coach by:

- Assisting with offensive & defensive structure and strategies
- Assisting in the delivery of training camps and other program activities during the event
- Assisting with the assessment and monitoring of athlete performance during the event
- Monitoring and reporting on any matters concerning Squad members' behaviour and discipline
- Ensuring compliance with Softball Australia's Australian Teams Policy, Anti-Doping Policy, Member Protection Policy and any other relevant policies and regulations
- Undertaking other relevant tasks agreed with the Head Coach

- A minimum of two years' experience as a softball coach at an international, national, state or equivalent level

- An understanding of and empathy for the needs of elite athletes
- Demonstrated success in managing individual differences and group dynamics
