New Rules Assessment Portal Registration Process


 **The following process must be followed in order to register correctly for the Rules Assessment Portal.**

Step 1

Apply for an invitation through the Rules Assessment Registration portal provided by Softball Australia.

PLAYING RULES ASSESSMENT PROCESS AND DATES AVAILABILITY

There are two types of Playing Rules Assessment available.

OPEN RULES ASSESSMENT
12.01am AEST – Saturday 20th April – 11.59pm AEST Sunday 28th April 2019

- Open – More difficult type rules. For Players, Coaches, Level 0 – 8 umpires.
- We encourage everyone wanting to test their advanced knowledge to sit this Open Rules Assessment; it is available only during set times of the year.
- The Open Rules Assessment must be undertaken by umpires every second year to maintain their accreditation and every year for umpires wanting to advance their accreditation.
- Level 0-1 umpires may sit this Assessment, if they do not meet the required pass mark, they then may sit the Basic Assessment to apply for accreditation assessment.

BASIC RULES ASSESSMENT
1st May – 31st March every year

- Basic – Easy type questions on everyday plays and situations. Level 0 – 1 umpires.
- The Basic Rules Assessment can be undertaken anytime from May through to March (closed for April).
- We welcome players, coaches, scorers, officials and parents to test their knowledge.

REGISTRATION OR ASSESSMENT LINKS

2019 sees a new cloud-based platform for the rules assessment portal with a new web address. The old site will be closed down as of the 31 Dec 2018.

All users will need to register for 2019, for either the Open and/or the Basic formats.

This form is used to register your interest and seek an invitation.

Note - after submitting this form, you **must wait to receive an email invitation** from our online rules assessment provider.

Please wait for this email invitation and use the link provided *in the email*.

 You cannot access the site directly and set up a user into the system, as it needs to know you belong to Softball Australia. We do that for you and the system then sends you an email invitation.

If you have an active user name and password there is no need to register, simply go the Softball Australia web site Umpiring Program, "Rules Assessment" page and click to enter the Assessment Portal.

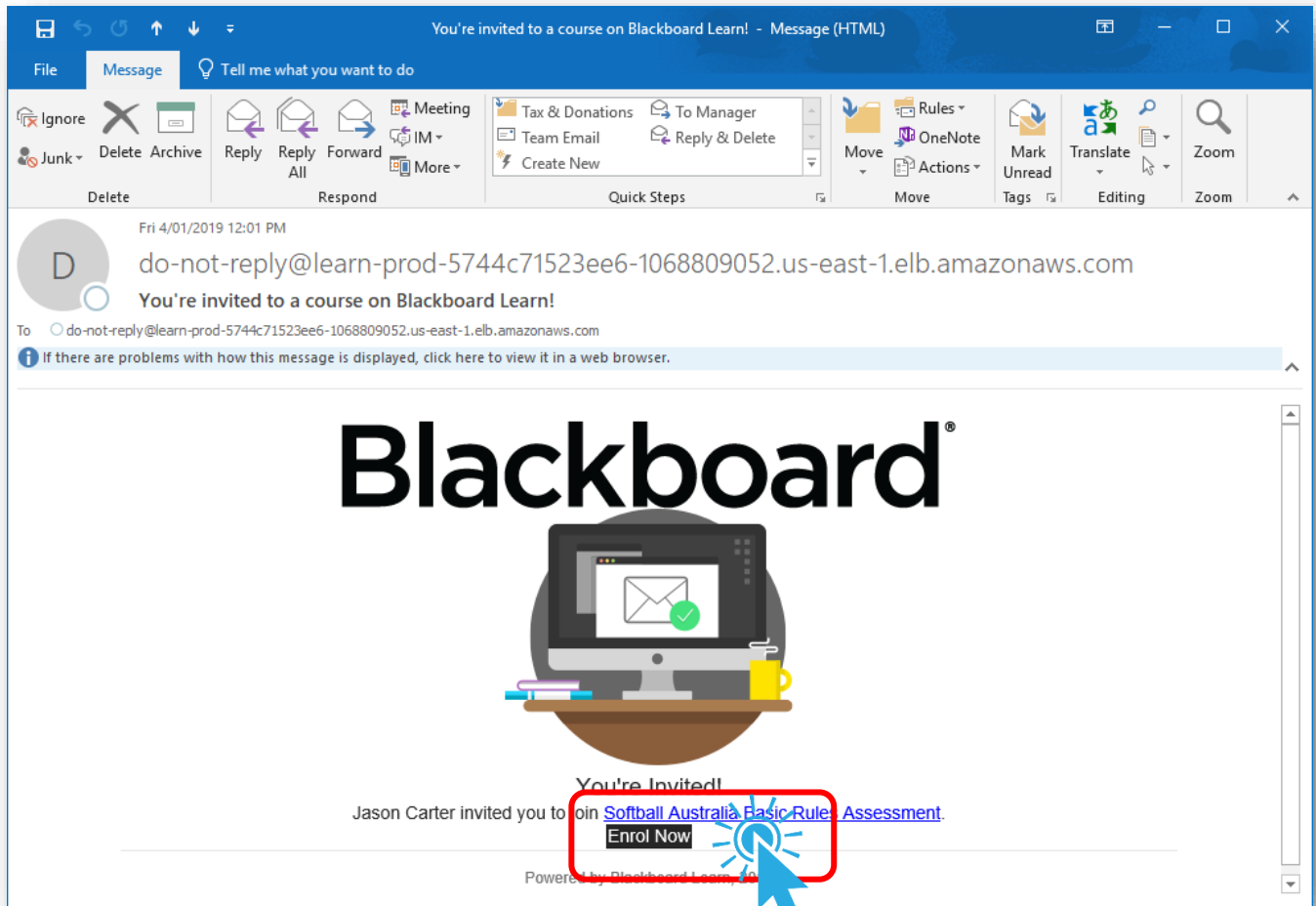
